

Currently, 15 of the FBI's Special Agents in Charge or Assistant Directors are African-American. We are proud of that fact, but we know we need to do more to continue to attract qualified minorities to our organization.

To that end, the FBI has launched a number of innovative programs. Among these are an internship program for students at historically black colleges and universities, and an exciting new partnership with EdVenture, where the FBI sponsors university courses that let students design and manage a campaign to market the FBI on their local campus. Such a course was just approved for the Fall 2004 semester at Florida A&M University.


Congratulations! I am sure you will do a great job as the president of the Jacksonville Bar Association.


Dear Reg:



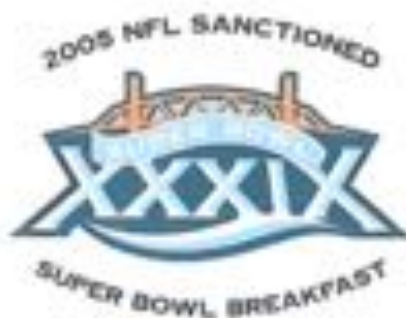
